HOW TO SET UP AN ERC

Requirements:

- 1. Attendee's must be a GWRRA member in good standing.**
- 2. Attendee's must have a motorcycle endorsement on their license.**
- 3. Attendee's must be enrolled in the Rider Education Program, Level I or above.**
- 4. Motorcycle must pass a T-Clock inspection.**

Procedure:

- 1. Make a list of members who will be taking the course, 6 minimum**
- 2. Collect from each Rider a check for \$35.00, payable to "Florida GWRRA Rider Education." Checks will be returned to the member upon successful completion of the course. "No shows" will forfeit their deposit.**
- 3. Select two dates, at least two months ahead, mail dates and checks to *JOE MAZZA*.**
- 4. *JOE* will set up the course in your area, and will notify you of time, date and place.**

Helpful Hints:

- 1. Instructors will be sent the Waiver forms (both Rider and Co-rider), Class Completion Cards, Certificate of Insurance and other documents to comply with State Licensing Agreements.**
- 2. Riders and Co-riders are required to fill out and sign Waiver forms. No exceptions.**
- 3. Riders and Co-riders are required to wear full safety gear including: DOT approved 3/4 or full helmet, eye protection, full fingered gloves, long sleeved shirt or jacket, pants and over the ankle foot protection. No exceptions.**
- 4. Upon completion of the course, members will be given their completion cards and a Level form allowing them to move to Level II or Level III or renew at their current Level.**
